The Academy Newsletter:

This is The Academy's monthly newsletter. Schools from Miami-Dade and Broward follow this newsletter closely as it contains program updates and information on grants, green community events and schools' green initiatives. This newsletter is sent to all program participants and is published in DIG's social media pages.

Dream Journal:

This is DIG's quarterly newsletter. It contains DIG's news, featured articles on environmental sustainability, articles from community partners and updates on our programs. One newsletter is released every July, October, January, and April and is sent to over 10,000 DIG supporters in Miami's green community. The Dream Journal is published in DIG's social media pages.

Academy Guidebook/Curriculum:

The Academy Guidebook is DIG's resource manual that guides teachers and Green Teams through the process of implementing environmental education programs in their school. It contains action plans, pledges, monthly challenge activities, and all the tools teachers and students need to succeed in their green journey. The Guidebook is distributed to all schools participating in the program. 110 public, private, and charter K-12 schools are enrolled in The Academy's 2015-2016 program cycle.

WE-LAB

The Water and Energy Learning and Behavior (WE-LAB) Program teaches concrete steps to change water and energy use patterns to reduce our regional greenhouse gas emissions and save you money. This will be done through educational workshops, classroom learning, and an interactive website. Twenty workshops will be held over the course of one year, with participation of 50 + residents per workshop. _______
