Dream in Green invites all public, private and charter schools to enroll in the Dream in Green Academy. The Academy is a platform that delivers innovative environmental education programs for K-12 schools. Students, teachers, administration staff and parents are encouraged to design and implement solutions to address environmental challenges in their school. Students become stewards of the environment by completing activities from classroom projects to community campaigns.

Schools receive a guidebook with clear guidelines on how to complete the program. Dream in Green staff offers support to help schools save energy and conserve water, consequently reducing their carbon footprint and save money on utility bills.

Dream in Green has been offering environmental education programs to K-12 schools for ten years. The Academy builds on the success of the Green Schools Challenge, DIG's flagship program, which started as a pilot in three schools and is now implemented in over 100 schools every year.

Applications for the 2016-2017 program are being accepted now.

Program Features



- Support to schools and teachers through site visits, emails and e-newsletters.
- Master Plan points offered to MDCPS teachers who attend the professional development training in the Fall 2016.
- Successes are celebrated at the End-of-Year Awards Ceremony in June 2017.

- Students develop leadership, teamwork and critical thinking skills.

How to Participate

1: For the 2016-2017 academic year we are offering three programs: the *Green Schools Challenge*, *Water and Energy, Learning and Behavior* (WE-LAB) program, and the *Green City Challenge* offered by the Coral Gables Museum.

New schools or schools that have been enrolled in the Dream in Green Academy for one or two years must enroll in the Green Schools Challenge. Participants learn the basics of sustainability and build a 'green' foundation for their school.

The WE-LAB and Green City Challenge programs are offered as 'graduate' programs. Dream in Green staff assigns schools to one of the programs according to their performance completing the GSC in previous years.
