Vocabulary

Adopt a School Sponsorship Program:

This program emerged to allow corporations or key individuals to help deliver the Green Schools Challenge or WE-LAB program to the K-12 schools of their choice. Sponsors help educate students about the need for energy and water conservation as well as waste reduction and can participate in 'green' activities and events in the schools they adopt.

The Dream in Green Academy:

The Academy is a new education platform that promotes collaboration with other community organizations to introduce environmental education programs to K-12 schools. In 2015-2016, Dream in Green is implementing the Green Schools Challenge, WE-LAB and the Coral Gables Museum's Green City Challenge.

WE-LAB:

The Water and Energy Learning and Behavior (WE-LAB) was designed to educate students, teachers and community residents about the fundamental relationship between water and energy. WE-LAB provides participants low-to-no-cost solutions that help them save money while promoting behaviors that benefit the entire community.

The Academy E-newsletter:

This is The Academy's monthly e-newsletter. Schools from Miami-Dade and Broward follow this newsletter closely as it contains program updates and information on grants, community green events and school's green initiatives. This e-newsletter is sent to all program participants and is published on DIG's social media pages.

Dream Journal:

This is DIG's quarterly e-newsletter. It contains program news, featured articles on environmental sustainability, articles from community partners and updates on our programs. One e-newsletter is released every July, October, January, and April and is sent to all DIG supporters in Miami's green community.
