Grants for Green Leadership: Students Implement Change

- ✓ 10 grants of \$500 given to GSC/WE-LAB schools
- ✓ Between 4 to 30 student members in the implementation team
- ✓ Projects implemented educated between 100 to 2,000 K-12 grade students
- ✓ 100% of participants said the program developed leadership skills and empowered the youth.
- ✓ 100% of program participants said they would like mini-grants available in 2014-2015
