Vocabulary

Green Schools Challenge (GSC) Newsletter: Official GSC monthly newsletter. Schools from Miami-Dade County follow this newsletter closely as it contains program updates and information on grants, community green events and highlights school's green initiatives. This newsletter is sent to all Miami-Dade public, charter and private schools, and the Miami-Dade Public School District.

Dream Journal: This is DIG's quarterly newsletter. It contains DIG news, features articles on environmental sustainability, articles from community partners and updates on our programs. One newsletter is released every July, October, January, and April and it is sent to all DIG supporters in the green community.

GSC Guidebook: The GSC Guidebook is DIG's resource manual that guides teachers and Green Teams through the process of implementing the program at their school. It contains action plans, pledges, monthly challenge activities, lesson plans and all the tools teachers and students need to succeed in their green journey. The 2014-2015 GSC Guidebook will be distributed to all schools participating in the program. We estimate about 165 public, private, and charter K-12schools will be enrolling in the GSC this school year.

Monthly Topics: There are six different monthly topics proposed in the GSC Guidebook including, Energy Efficiency and Conservation, Waste Reduction & Recycling, Water Conservation, Green Buildings, Green Transportation and Green Careers. These topics are critical to long-term community sustainability and changing personal behaviors that conserve resources at school and at home.

Monthly Challenge Activities: The monthly topics translate into monthly challenge activities. The GSC Guidebook provides a selection of six fun and challenging activities to choose from for each monthly topic. Sponsors will be able to work with DIG staff to write up one activity for students to complete and learn from.

WE-LAB: The **W**ater and **E**nergy **L**earning **a**nd **B**ehavior (WE-LAB) Program teaches concrete steps to change water and energy use patterns to reduce our regional greenhouse gas emissions and save you money. This will be done through educational workshops, classroom learning, and an interactive website. A minimum of 25 workshops will be held over the course of one year, with an anticipated participation of 50 + residents per workshop.
